My Artist Statement

On your Outside In gallery page, you can add an artist statement. An artist statement is a professional tool to help people understand your artwork.

Words about the kinds of art I like to make: e.g. *drawing, painting, stitching, sculpting, glass work*

Words about art materials I like to use: e.g. *paint, pencil crayons, watercolour, yarn, fabric, buttons beads, batik, clay, plaster, mixed media, found or recycled materials*

Understanding my choices

What is my favourite colour? How does this colour make me feel? Do I use colour very much in my artwork?

What is my favourite material? Why do I like to work this way? *E.g. I like to work big, I like to make expressive marks (paint); I like to make tiny details (pencil), I like to be messy (clay), I like how it feels (yarn)*

What is my favourite style or technique? *E.g. I like my work to look real, I like to work abstractly, I like to create patterns, I like my work to be random*

Creating meaning for myself and others

Why do you think art is important? *E.g. art helps me express myself, or art makes me feel good about myself.*
