



Call out information for residency at CGP London

Applications are now open for Outside In artists based in Greater London* to take part in a collaborative residency and exhibition based at CGP London.

About the project

'Park Life' is an exciting new residency developed by Outside In, The Bethlem Gallery and CGP London. It will see three artists, one from each organisation, come together and create new work which will then be exhibited at CGP London. Working under the chosen theme of 'Park Life', the selected artists will have the opportunity to create artwork which responds to the unique setting of CGP London, Southwark Park. The theme is designed to be very broad and the artists will have the opportunity to explore it together. The residency is 13 days long and artists will each be paid £200 a day. There will also be a materials budget available and the selected artist will be supported by an artist mentor appointed by Outside In. Applications will be judged by Outside In director Marc Steene and CGP London director Judith Carlton.

What we are looking for

The nature of this project requires artists to enjoy working with other people. We are interested in all different types of artworks including; textiles, sculpture, prints, painting, drawing and more. This call-out is for Outside In artists, based in London, who would like to develop their practise by working with two other artists to learn skills, spark inspiration, create new work and exhibit.

*Applicants need to be a resident of one of the 32 London boroughs or of The City of London.

How to apply

Artists can apply through their online gallery with Outside In.

How to submit

Each artist living within Greater London can submit two pieces of work each for consideration for the

residency and exhibition. The judges will go through each work digitally to make the selection. You can submit only one piece if you wish. There is no limit on size.

All of the selections happen digitally, so if you do not already have an Outside In online gallery then you will have to create one. Go to the 'sign up' tab on top of the Outside In website and follow the instructions. Please contact us if you have difficulty doing this or see the 'need help' section below.

If you already have an online gallery, log in to your page on the Outside In website. You can upload new works if you wish, or choose images on your online gallery already.

The submission process

Click 'edit' on the image you wish to submit. At the bottom of the page will be a tick box for you to enter the work for selection to the London exhibition. Make sure that you click 'save' before leaving the page. This will notify Outside In of your submission/s. You can of course upload new work to submit, rather than use work already on your page. A maximum of two submissions can be made. Do remember that you must put in the dimensions and materials used for each picture you are submitting.

If you change your mind on your submissions, you need to click 'edit' on the image already submitted, un-tick the box and press 'save'. You can then go to the image that you would like to submit instead, click 'edit' and tick the box for that image instead.

Closing date for submissions is: Monday 10 December 2018

Dates and deadline


The residency will take place over 13 days, this will include four-days when the artists get to know each other and will be followed by a nine-day residency at CGP London to make new work together in the space.

Residency at CGP London: Tuesday 5 March – Friday 15 March 2019

Exhibition at CGP London: 20 March – 28 April 2019
